The EU guarantees the right to work in all Member States. Doing the relevant Bachelor or Masters degree also allows OSH Managers to work in any EU country.

Unfortunately, not all countries have agreed on the details of this and a final decision has not yet been made by the EU Parliament. This is where ENSPHO comes into play with the EU Project EUSafe which defines what qualification is needed to become an OSH Manager.

Due to increased globalisation, more and more companies from Europe and America are expanding into Asia, Africa and South America. However, high standards in occupational safety and health are often not understood on building sites and to a certain extent clash with social culture.

Work is often done by unskilled workers without training who are not sufficiently equipped with the right PSA. As a result, there are more and more tragic workplace accidents.

Therefore, the definition, acceptance and use of standards in health and safety as well as the qualification of SH Managers are key to the development of a global, sustainable culture of prevention.
